Quality Improvement Training programme 2016-17

As you will have heard at autumn term provider briefings, the basic format of the training subscription scheme will remain the same as in previous years, enabling you to purchase a training subscription based on a number of training credits (previously know as training places), which you can then use against your preferred training courses.

Although the majority of courses offered through the subscription scheme will be of 1 day duration, there will be a few courses of 2 or more day's duration, as these have proved very popular in previous years. Places on these courses will now require more than 1 training credit to be used and full details of the number of credits required will be shown on the QIWD training programme flyer available on our web page <http://www3.hants.gov.uk/childcare/providers/childcaretraining>

Safeguarding courses will no longer be included in the SfYC Training Subscription scheme. However, safeguarding courses will still be available through HCC but will need to be booked via the Learning Zone and paid for separately.

Previous scheme members will not need to set up another account on the Learning Zone, as the account will be updated with your new 2016/17 training credit details.

The 2016/17 training programme is now available on the SfYC website to view, prior to purchasing your training credits.

To subscribe:

Training credits must be purchased in the period **Monday 8 February – midnight Friday 15 April 2016** using the online form <http://www.hants.gov.uk/childrens-services/childcare/providers/childcaretraining/training-funding.htm> or by downloading the application form and sending it with cheque/BACS evidence attached to us.

If you choose not to join the 2016/17 scheme, you can purchase EYFS training at **£110 per training credit** payable on booking - this is non-refundable.

Please note: Participation in the 2016/17 subscription scheme will provide you/your setting access to e-learning licences/downloadable training materials. Access is restricted to a maximum of 4 per setting irrespective of the number of training credits purchased.
