### Changes to the Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI) funding from 1 April 2016

---

The range of data that informs the IDACI which feeds into the IDACI bandings has recently been reviewed. This occurs every 5 years on a national level and uses the most up to date data on statistics such as unemployment levels, number of households claiming a benefit, crime levels etc.

The informed is used to produce a level of deprivation (the IDACI level). Each postcode in the country is given a score; this score is used to put the postcodes into local bandings. Further information on IDACI funding can be found on the website link below.

To see the potential impact on your setting you will need your DfE URN number and enter this onto the checker that has been produced to give an indication of the IDACI funding changes based what you would have been paid for children attending your setting in 2015.
